



Memorandum of Understanding Church Women United and World Day of Prayer USA

World Day of Prayer has been an integral part of the lives of churchwomen in the United States since the prayer movement's inception. Church Women United (CWU) units across the country continue to gather in celebrations of this special day on the first Friday in March annually. For many years CWU was the national sponsor of World Day of Prayer in the United States. In 2005, the World Day of Prayer International Committee established a World Day of Prayer USA Committee to oversee WDP in the US.

Church Women United and the World Day of Prayer USA both carry notes on their financial books regarding "accounts receivable" from one another. In a spirit of reconciliation and for valuable consideration hereby acknowledged and received, both entities mutually agree to discharge each other's liabilities to the extent that such liabilities may exist and will remove these "accounts receivable" from their respective books and declare a Jubilee Year.

Working together for peace and reconciliation we can make a difference in our churches, our communities, and our world.

This memorandum was received and approved by the National Board of Church Women United in March 2014 and the World Day of Prayer USA Board of Directors in March 2014.
